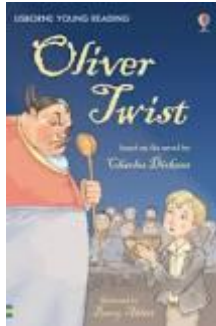


Get Reading!

Get Drawing!

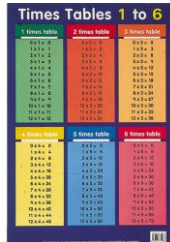
Make a wanted poster for Dick Turpin using old techniques, e.g. printing blocks.
